Gambler's Help is a free service, providing counselling for people who are experiencing difficulties as a result of their gambling, as well as those who are affected by someone else's gambling.

Gambler's Help provides support, education, information, referrals and therapeutic counselling to support people to address their gambling issues.

The program also offers financial counselling to assist with sorting out finances affected by gambling. Community Education Sessions are also available to anyone in the community who wishes to find out more about gambling. This includes welfare workers, schools, community groups, client groups and the general public.
