



Family Violence program

PCC's **Family Violence Program** is a free and confidential service, supporting those who are currently experiencing Family Violence.

Family Violence can include physical assault, emotional and psychological abuse, coercion and threats, intimidation and isolation, financial and spiritual abuse.

The Family Violence Case Management Program will provide the following support:

- Risk management by using a MARAM (multi agency risk assessment management tool) with the client
- Regular safety planning
- Education, information and support for those experiencing family violence
- Pathways to recovery
- Advocacy
- Referral to services, including counselling, housing, material aid, health, legal and court support
- Goal setting
- Case planning
- Support when making statements to police and applying for applications for IVO's

Eligibility:

- Experiencing current family violence
- Living in City of Greater Shepparton, Strathbogie or Moira Shires
- Over 16 years of age
- Willingness to engage with Family Violence Support

Our **Family Violence Program** is available from our Shepparton office and also provides outreach services to Tatura, Numurkah, Cobram, Euroa and Yarrawonga.
