NAIDOC CARNIVAL

Primary Care Connect provided sponsorship to a group of women to enter a team into the NAIDOC carnival. SEVEN SISTERS INDIGENOUS NETBALL PROGRAM

Primary Care Connect sponsored a group of local young women and their families to attend the Australian Indigenous Schoolgirls Netball Carnival this is an initiative of the Budgies Australian Netball Indigenous Corporation (BANIC). The Budgies has been operating for over 10 years.

Every year, states and territories bring their players ranging in ages from 11 years to 19 years. The girls compete in the National carnival in January of each year. From there, Australian Indigenous Teams (known as Budgies) are selected and they compete in various carnivals throughout the year.

SHEPPARTON JUNIOR SOCCER ASSOCIATION

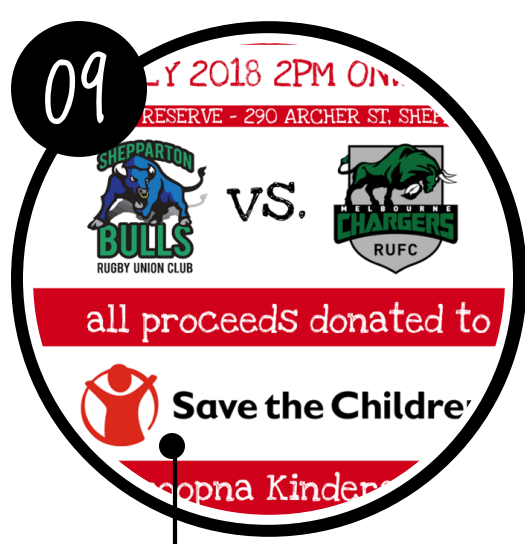
